PATRAS

I have been thinking of organizing a tour of my hometown, as many of my students have expressed an interest in visiting the place where I grew up and have since returned to live and work. On this trip, we will see important monuments and museums, taste local foods and drinks like "Τεντούρα," explore the city center, and visit some of my favorite restaurants and coffee shops. Patras is famous for its vibrant Carnival celebrations, "Πατρινό Καρναβάλι," a centuries-old tradition dating back to 1870 with roots in Ancient Greece. You'll experience the lively energy of this student city, home to over 33,000 students from across Greece. Patras University, one of the top-ranked universities in the country, is renowned for its engineering and aeronautical schools, both internationally acclaimed.



DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1. Fri, May 09: Arrival in Patras

Patras is accessible from Athens International Airport via the Suburban Rail Network (more info: <https://www.athenstransport.com/english/airport/>) or by Intercity Bus.

Check-in at the hotel. Afternoon welcome drink and **the first Greek conversational class**. Then, we meet in the lobby and take a short walk to a local restaurant for the welcome dinner. Overnight stay at Hotel Galaxy (or similar), with breakfast included the following morning. (D)



Day 2. Sat, May 10: Discovering Patras town



After breakfast, you will meet with Yiuli for your **morning Greek lesson**. Then, we'll have a walking tour of the city's center and visit its most significant landmarks, including the magnificent Agios Andreas Church, the third biggest Orthodox church in the Balkans with its characteristic neo-Byzantine architecture. Inside the church, the relics of Saint Andrew are stored.

Next, we'll explore the Press Museum, home to a rich collection of newspapers, magazines, and manuscripts, mainly from the past, offering valuable insight into the history of the city and country. Enjoy a delicious lunch (included) before returning to the hotel for relaxation. You are free to enjoy dinner in the evening. Overnight with breakfast at Hotel Galaxy or similar. (B, L)

Day 3. Sun, May 11:

Day trip to Nafpaktos, Crossing the Rio cable bridge

*After breakfast, meet with Yiuli for your **morning Greek lesson**. Then, board our private bus to visit the Patras Archaeological Museum, home to a fascinating collection of ancient artifacts, from ancient Mycenaean jewellery to Roman mosaics.*

Next, we will travel via the Rio-Antirio, one of the longest cable bridges in the world, towards the historic seaside town of Nafpaktos with its well-preserved Venetian Castle. Here, you'll have time to explore and enjoy a walk in town. After, we'll have a group lunch before returning to the hotel. Dinner on your own. Overnight stay with breakfast at Hotel Galaxy or similar. (B, L)



Day 4. Mon, May 12: Achaia Clauss Winery

*After breakfast, you will have **your Greek language class**. After the lesson, we board the private bus and visit a historic winery, Achaia Clauss, founded in 1861 on a hillside with a stunning city view. Enjoy a guided tour of the winery, explore the vineyards, and taste local varieties of wine like the renowned Mavrodaphni, a rich fortified red wine. Following the winery visit, we'll have a group lunch. You are free to enjoy dinner in the evening at your own pace. Overnight stay with breakfast at Hotel Galaxy or a similar accommodation. (B, L)*



Day 5. Tue, May 13: Walk on the hill

*Our final day in Patra will begin with breakfast, followed by your **Greek language class**. Then, we will walk through a charming little forest in the center of Patras named "Dasylio" and enjoy the beautiful view. In the evening, we'll gather for the farewell dinner. Overnight at Hotel Galaxy or a similar hotel, with breakfast included. (B, D)*



Day 6. Wed, May 14: Patras - Home

*After breakfast, have your **last Greek language class**. Then, you will make your way to the bus station at your leisure for your return journey to Athens.*

IOANNINA

Join Yiuli and Ourania for a winter adventure! We travel to Ioannina, the capital of Epirus, located in Northwestern Greece. It is built 500 meters above sea level next to the lake Pamvotida. It will be our base for a week.

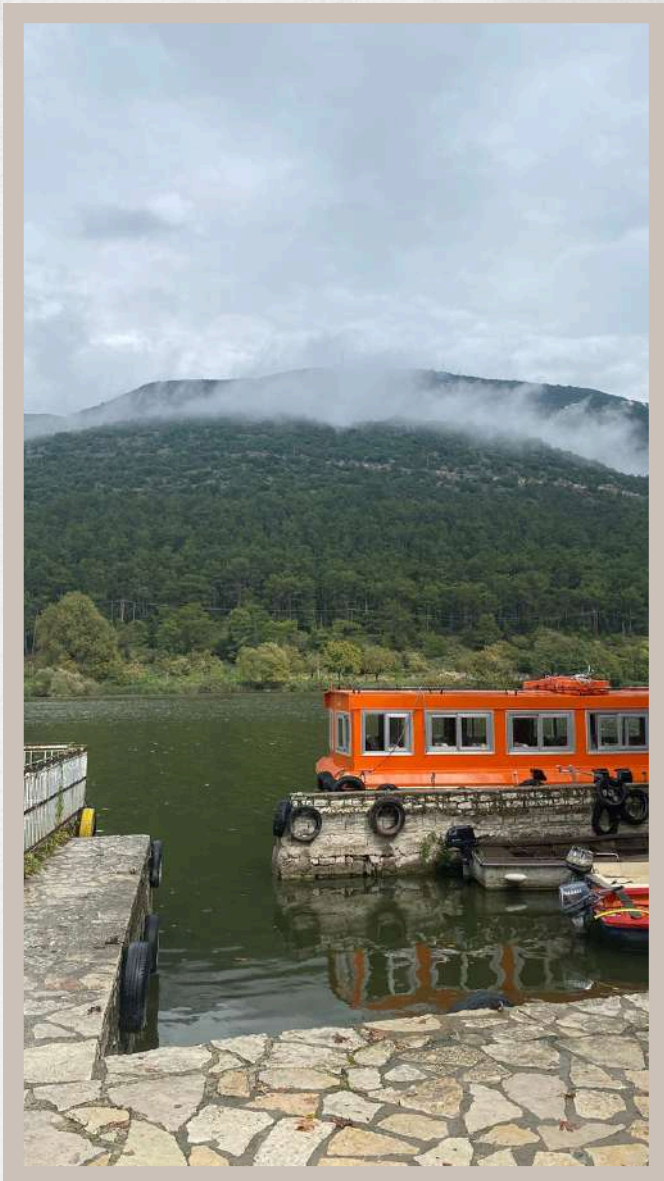
We will explore the city and its historical layers, which date back to the Byzantine era, the Ottoman Empire, and modern history. We will visit the small island on the lake, travel to Metsovo for a day trip, and taste the local cheese and wines.

We will hike along the Voidomatis River and enjoy the serene landscape. Oh, and yes, you will have a daily class in the Greek language with Yiuli before you are off to explore! So pack your winter mittens, woolen scarves, and socks, and meet us in Ioannina!



Day 1. Frid, 03 October: Arrival at Ioannina

*Individual arrivals and transfer (on your own) to the hotel. Check-in at hotel after 12noon. Walking tour of the Castro and the lake front. In the afternoon, meet your fellow travellers over a glass of wine at the courtyard of the hotel. We will have our first **Greek conversational session**, followed by our welcome dinner. Overnight with breakfast at Hotel Naiades. (D)*



Day 2. Sat, 04 October: Island of the lake

*Enjoy a delicious breakfast, followed by your **Greek lesson** with Yiuli. Meet at the lobby and depart on foot to the pier and board the boat to cross over to the inlet of the lake. Visit the museum of Ali Pascha with historical artefacts, costumes and documents of the Ottoman era. Group lunch. Free evening. Overnight with breakfast at Hotel Naiades. (B, L)*

Day 3. Sun, 05 October: ZITSA village

*Enjoy your breakfast, followed at by **your Greek lesson** with Yiuli. Meet at the hotel lobby and walk to our bus. Today we will travel to Zitsa and learn how to make the famous local pies, savoury and sweet. We will get our hands covered in flour and olive oil, as we will have a go and make our own pie and have it for lunch! Return to Ioannina. Overnight with breakfast at Hotel Naiades. (B, L)*



Day 4 - Monday, 06 October: METSOVO

*Enjoy a delicious breakfast, followed **by your Greek lesson** with Yiuli. Meet at the hotel lobby to board our private bus for a full day of sightseeing and history at the picturesque village of Metsovo. As this region is famous for its cheese production from goat, sheep and cow's milk, we will have a tasting/pairing of local cheeses with local wine. Visit to the Folklore museum and have a glimpse of how life was in the late 1800's. Free time for Lunch (on your own) and to explore the village. Greek conversation. Overnight with breakfast at Hotel Naiades. (B)*

Day 5. Tues, 07 October: HIKING in Vikos Gorge

As this day is quite challenging - physically- please wear layers of clothing and good, sturdy, non slippery hiking shoes. Bring some snacks, nuts and plenty of water.

*Enjoy a delicious breakfast, followed by your **Greek lesson** with Yiuli. After class, put on your hiking boots for a day in beautiful mountainous scenery! we meet at the lobby and walk to our private bus. Continue with our bus to Aristi village. We will be dropped off and hike together the 5klm alongside the river 'Voidomatis'. (about 3 hours). Group farewell lunch (included). Return early afternoon to the hotel for some rest. Free evening to explore the city. Overnight with breakfast at Hotel Naiades. (B, L)*

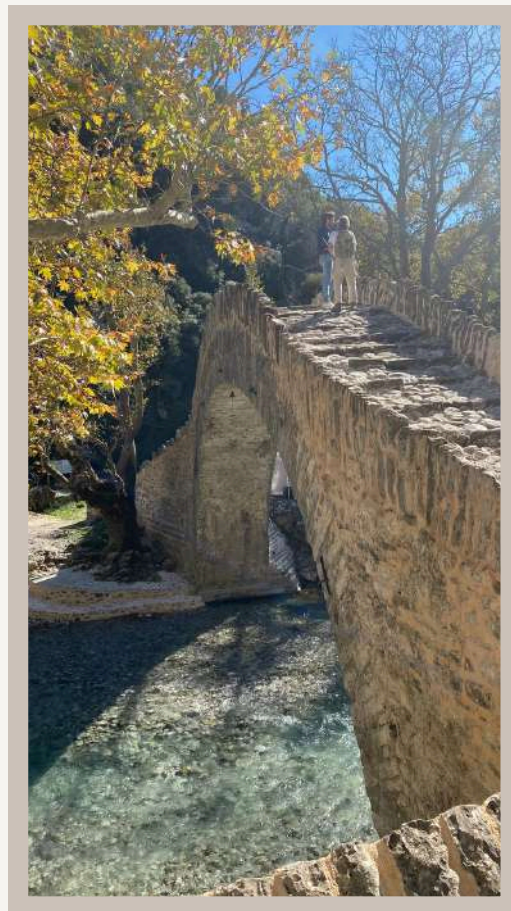
